

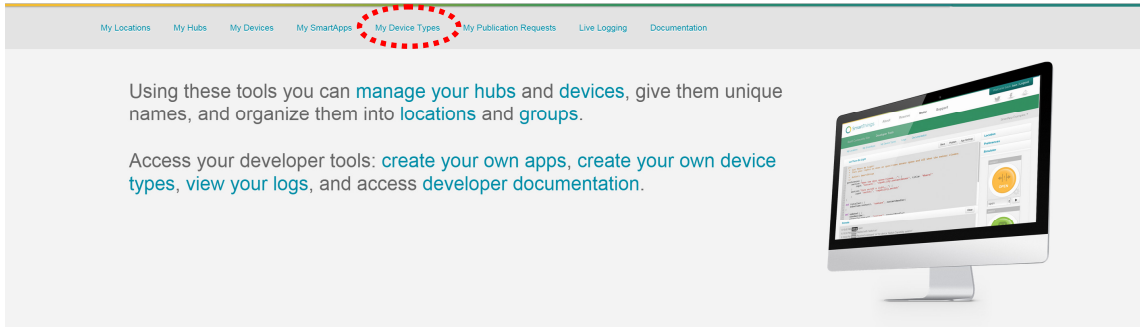

## HOW-TO: Add Your Fidure A1-730 Thermostat to SmartThings Home Automation Hub.

**Part-I Adding Fidure A1730's Device Type profile to SmartThings platform (so your hub can recognize and work with A1730).**

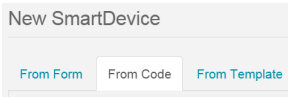
1. Register an account at <https://graph.api.smartthings.com/> - Once registered, log into your account.



2. Click on "My Device Types" on the top menu (highlighted below)
3. Click on the 'New SmartDevice' button on the top right hand side.

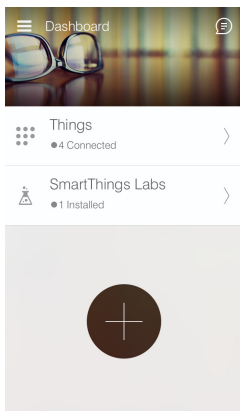
4. Next, click on 'From Code' Tab



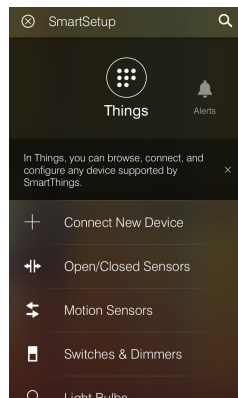
5. Open a new browser tab and copy the contents of A1730's device type <https://www.fidure.com/docs/A1-730-SmartThings.txt> into clip board(e.g. Ctrl-A then Ctrl-C in Windows and Cmd-A Cmd-C in OSX)
6. Paste the device type code into SmartThings IDE.
7. Click Create to finish Part-I.

## Part-II Commissioning your Thermostat to your Home Automation Network.

1. Download and run the SmartThings app from the App-store.
2. Once Logged-in, tap on the Plus Sign (+) to add a new device.



3. Next tap on 'Connect New Device'.
4. Follow the instructions in your manual for connecting the A1730 Thermostat to the ZigBee network.



5. Your device is now part of the Home Automation network and you can use the SmartThings App and Smart Apps to control your device.
